#### Biography:

Dr Shakti Singh Graduated from Manipal College of Dental Sciences in India and later finished his Post graduate studies in Orthodontics from the same institution. Originally from New Delhi, Dr. Singh was an outstanding student accumulating numerous awards and achievements including the Indian Dental Association Scholarship for 1st place standing in the final year dental exams.

Wanting to pursue orthodontics in Canada, Dr. Singh was able to secure a spot in graduate Orthodontic program, at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, for foreign trained orthodontists. Since finishing his 2nd residency, Dr. Singh worked as an active partner and later as an owner at "Smiles in Motion" orthodontic office in Brantford.

Dr. Singh's areas of interest are- use of temporary anchorage devices in moderate to severe skeletal discrepancy cases to produce orthognathic surgery like results and use of clear aligner therapy to effectively and efficiently treat adults and children alike.

#### **Course Outline:**

Class I and Class II malocclusions make a bulk of orthodontic cases in a dental practice. It is a challenge to accurately diagnose and distinguish mild to moderately difficult cases from very complex cases which deceptively appear simple. An incorrect diagnosis results in an inappropriate treatment plan which may lead to improper bite, poor facial esthetics and excessive time to finish a case.

This course will focus on 5 basic/key points which will help you assess and plan a case in the most appropriate and efficient way.

The 10 most prescribed Drugs: What you need to know

#### **Biography Dr Aviv Ouanounou:**

Dr. Aviv Ouanounou is an assistant professor of pharmacology and Preventive Dentistry at the faculty of dentistry, University of Toronto. He received both his DDS and MSc at the University of Toronto. He teaches pharmacology and Preventive Dentistry to undergraduate and graduate students and is also a clinical instructor and Treatment Plan Coordinator. Dr. Ouanounou won



numerous teaching awards including wining "Best Teacher of the Year Award" three times: in 2013, 2015 and just recently in 2019. Also, Dr. Ouanounou is the recipient of the 2014-2015 prestigious Dr. Bruce Hord Master Teacher Award for excellence in teaching at the Faculty of Dentistry at the University of Toronto. Dr. Ouanounou is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists. He is a member of the American Academy of Pain Management and the American College of Clinical Pharmacology. He has published and authored numerous articles in peer-reviewed journals. He also maintains a general private practice in Toronto.

#### The 10 most prescribed drugs: What do you need to know?

Pharmacology is the study of Drugs and their effects on the human body. Chronic medical conditions such as cancer, cardiovascular disease, endocrine disorders and neurological conditions are very prevalent worldwide. In this course we will discuss the top 10 prescribed drugs in North America. We will review the pharmacological actions of these drugs, any reported adverse reactions and drug interactions associated with their use. We will review the effects of these medications on the oral cavity and any needed dental modifications for these patients. Specific emphasis will be given to the effects and interactions of these commonly prescribed drugs with those often given by dentists namely, local anaesthetics, analgesics, antibiotics and antifungals.

Dr. Hassanpour graduated from the University of Toronto in 2008 with a degree in Cellular and Molecular Biology (HBSc). In 2010, Dr. Hassanpour entered the Doctor of Dental Surgery program at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto. Dr. Hassanpour entered the Periodontology Speciality program in 2014 and earned his speciality training and degree in Periodontics (MSc Perio) at the University of Toronto in 2017. Dr. Hassanpour is a licensed periodontal specialist and a board-



certified periodontist. He has a practice limited to Periodontology in North York and is a part time clinical instructor at the University of Toronto's Graduate Periodontology Clinic. Dr. Hassanpour is currently serving as the past-president of the Toronto Central Dental Society, is a ODA general council member and is an executive on the Ontario Society of Periodontology.

#### Dr. Ryan Schure, DDS, MSc (Perio), FRCD(C)

Dr. Ryan Schure earned his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from the University of Toronto in 2010. He went on to complete his Master of Science degree with advanced training in periodontology and implant surgery at the University of Toronto. His research on the relationships between cardiovascular diseases and periodontal diseases has been published and presented at international meetings. Dr. Schure is a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada and a Diplomate of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. He is currently on the executive of the North Toronto Dental Society and Alpha Omega Dental Society. He continues to maintain strong affiliation to the University of Toronto as an Associate in Dentistry, where he contributes to the clinical and didactic training of undergraduate and graduate dental.

# Classification and diagnosis of periodontal and peri-implant diseases and conditions: Putting the new classification system into practice

A classification scheme for periodontal and peri-implant diseases is necessary for clinicians to properly diagnose and treat patients as well as for researchers to investigate etiology, pathogenesis, natural history, and treatment of the diseases and conditions. The previous (1999) classification system has been widely utilized for the past twenty years, but since this was developed, substantial new information has emerged about these conditions and diseases. The analysis of this evidence has prompted the development of a new classification framework for periodontitis. This 3-hour lecture-based course will review the proceedings of the World Workshop on the Classification of Periodontal and Peri-implant Diseases and Conditions from 2017, where the former classification was revised and expanded. The diagnosis of gingival health, gingivitis, periodontitis, peri-implant diseases, and other conditions affecting the periodontist using the new classification system will be reviewed using cases and allowing clinicians to implement this into their practice immediately.

- Compare and contrast the new classification system to the 1999 classification system and review the major difference between the systems
- Be able to classify and diagnose: periodontal health, gingival health, gingivitis, periodontitis, peri-implant health, peri-implant mucositis, peri-implantitis, mucogingival defect, periodontalendodontic infections and other periodontal disease
- Understand the new classification of periodontitis including the staging and grading of periodontal disease
