# BONE GRAFTING TECHNIQUE FOR THE GENERAL DENTIST

Speaker: Dr. Patrick Chu



Recently, Implant Dentistry has become well accepted into the main stream of a dental practice. Patients are demanding dental implants from their General Dentists. In order to have esthetic implant restorations, implants have to be ideally positioned into an ideal bony ridge.

Unfortunately, most of the time, the bony ridges are deficient either in width or height or both. This presentation will address different techniques of implant site development through preservation and regeneration so that implants can be placed at ideal positions and esthetic results can be achieved.

Dr. Patrick Chu graduated from the University Of Toronto Faculty Of Dentistry in 1983. He has been practicing Implant Dentistry since 1986, both the surgical and prosthetic. He has successfully incorporated Implant Dentistry with Orthodontic and Cosmetic Dentistry into his private practice. Dr. Chu received his extensive Implant training from Harvard University, Piko's Institute, Pat Allen's Oral Plastic Surgery Courses, Misch's Implant Institute and Sclar Centre.

### WHY DO BLOCKS FAIL? PITFALLS AND SOLUTIONS

Local anesthetic failure can be a frustrating aspect of dental practice for both the patient and the dentist.

This lecture will highlight the key reasons for local anesthesia failure and describe techniques to overcome them. A rational approach to failed local anesthesia will be discussed.

Dr. Ravi Vasudeva is a specialist in Dental Anesthesia. He is affiliated with the University of Toronto, Department of Anesthesia, as an instructor supervising pediatric general anesthesia.
