In addition to the conventional periodontal procedures such as pocket reduction and crown lengthening, Dr. Bhide has a special interest in esthetic and reconstructive periodontics; procedures involved include soft tissue grafting for correction of gingival recession, periodontal regeneration, and pre-prosthetic development including ridae alveolar augmentation, maxillary sinus floor augmentation (both direct and indirect), and guided bone regeneration (GBR).

Dr. Bhide earned this DDS from the University of Toronto in 2001, and subsequently completed a one year internship at Mount Sinai Hospital in Toronto. He completed his Master of Science and specialty training in Perodontology at the University of Toronto in 2005.
